I didn't feel she should have spoken like she did towards Andrew or Grandmother (me). She should have read paperwork that was sent in plenty of time towards this case. In my opinion things would have been handled much better for the safety of a child involved, at this time.

12. Any additional comments or supplemental information?

This case is a personal case dealing with me and my granddaughter on the safety & well being of her at this time. I filed paperwork according to what I was told to file and was told that it was all wrong.

I am not looking out for myself, nor son, nor mother involved, the welfare is my concern for Elizabeth, Age 2

The Magistrate should have been able to see in my paperwork the reasons for the motion. If they were wrong there should have been a notice before today's hearing that it would be postponed due to conflicts.

This was a drive of 50 miles round trip by father & Grandmother in a snow storm to not be able to provide information of whereabouts of child. To which mother has been living place to place. And not by the original court order paperwork.

This is the second time that this case has went no-where

- 1st EVENT - 11-25-2009 Setup visitation / custody
- 2nd EVENT 02-08-2010 Setup child support - not confirmed by courts
- 3rd EVENT 03-19-2010 - NO Idea what was suppose to take place. NO paperwork from the 3rd event
